Dear Mister Lindwall:

By virtue of the statements issued by Economist Carlos Marx Carrasco, General Director of the Internal Revenue Service of Ecuador (SRI), in which he affirms having "official" information from an alleged Attaché of the Investigation Office of the National Security Department of the United States Government, which could prove that lawyer Alvaro Noboa Ponton, entered the United States on Friday, March 15 of 2013, I, dutifully, stand before you to request for you to give official notice to the proper authorities to extend a certification stating that Lawyer Alvaro Noboa Ponton, identity card **0903686962, DID NOT ENTER**, the United States of America on Friday, March 15 of 2013.

Attached to this communication you will find a CD with the statements issued by Economist Carlos Marx Carrasco, which were broadcasted in national television through the news program of Gamatv, on Wednesday , April 17 of 2103, at 13:27.

Lawyer Alvaro Noboa Ponton left the country legally, after a Constitutional Judge granted him an Habeas Corpus which lifted the restriction of leaving the country that was issued against him in an illegal and unconstitutional way. The mentioned judgement, of March 20, remains in force because it hasn't been revoked by any Ecuadorian Judge, and as provided by our Constituion, only a Judge from the Judicial Function, not an administrative employee of the Internal Revenue Service, can issue a restriction on leaving the country.

I have nothing further to add, and for the attention you would bring to the present letter, I reiterate you our respect and friendship to the free people of the United States of America.
