ÁLVARO NOBOA, WILL LEAD AN OPPOSITION MARCH AGAINST THE REGIME

The Ecuadorian businessman, Alvaro Noboa, invites different political parties and movements and independent citizens opponents of the regime of Economist Rafael Correa, to join the protest march in Quito and Guayaquil, that will take place on Wednesday, September 16 2015 from 17h00.

In Guayaquil, the peaceful march will start at 17:00, it will depart from Malecon 512 between the Imbabura and Tomas Martinez streets and will end in the Guayas Governor's Office.

In Quito, the protest will start at 16h00 in front of the building of the Ecuadorian Social Security Institute (IESS).

Noboa has reiterated on several occasions that the purpose of the protest is "to ask for a return to true democracy and the resignation of Economist Rafael Correa". He has also said that he stands in solidarity with all groups opposed to the government as the FUT and indigenous movements.

"Nobody wants that Economist Rafael Correa perpetuates in power. If because of vanity opposition is not united, we will celebrate the 95th birthday of economist Rafael Correa in power, as happened with Fidel Castro. Let us unite!" stated the businessman.
